A new program has been started to collect juice drink pouches to benefit the National Fallen Firefighters Foundation. The Foundation will receive \$.02 for every drink pouch collected. These drink pouches are then turned into totes, which keeps them out of landfills since they are unable to be recycled.

So why not help families of fallen firefighters, help the environment, and be a part of a cool new trend?

Here are some ways you can help:

- To collect drink pouches, simply discard the straw, cut the top of the pouch as close to the top seam as you can get and rinse with warm water.
- Let your neighbors, family and friends know about this great program. Ask them to pass along their drink pouches or start their own collection.
- Firefighters, be sure to share this with your fellow firefighters and the community. The money raised will help us honor our fallen

and help their families. You could even set up a collection site in the station!

- Ask your local schools if you can place a collection site in the cafeteria and inform parents of the program.
- Think of other places you might set up collection sites such as: churches, community centers, libraries, grocery stores, etc.
- Spread the word. Send information about this fundraiser to your school and college ecology clubs.
- Contact your local paper with drop off locations.
